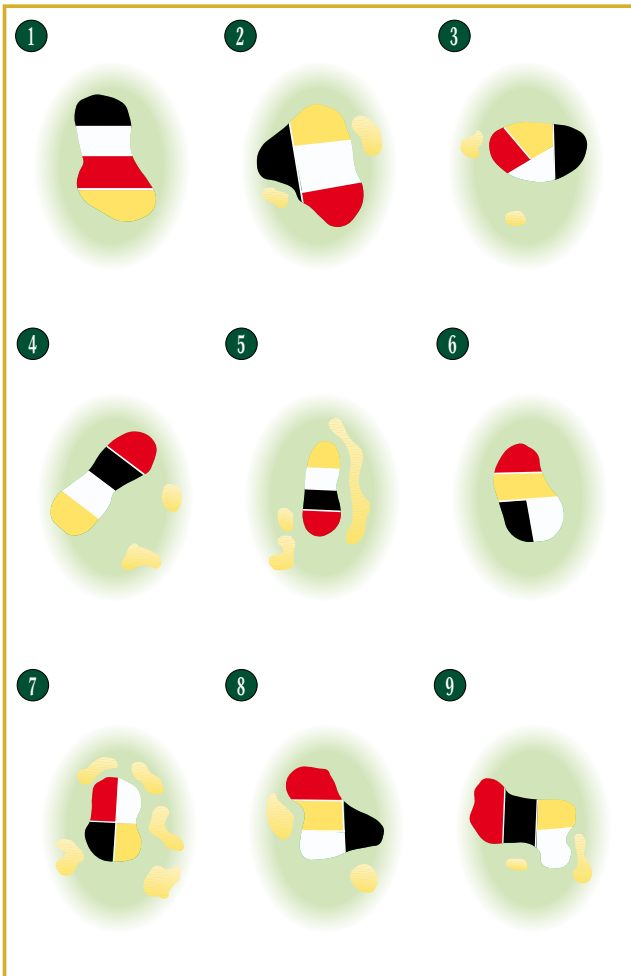
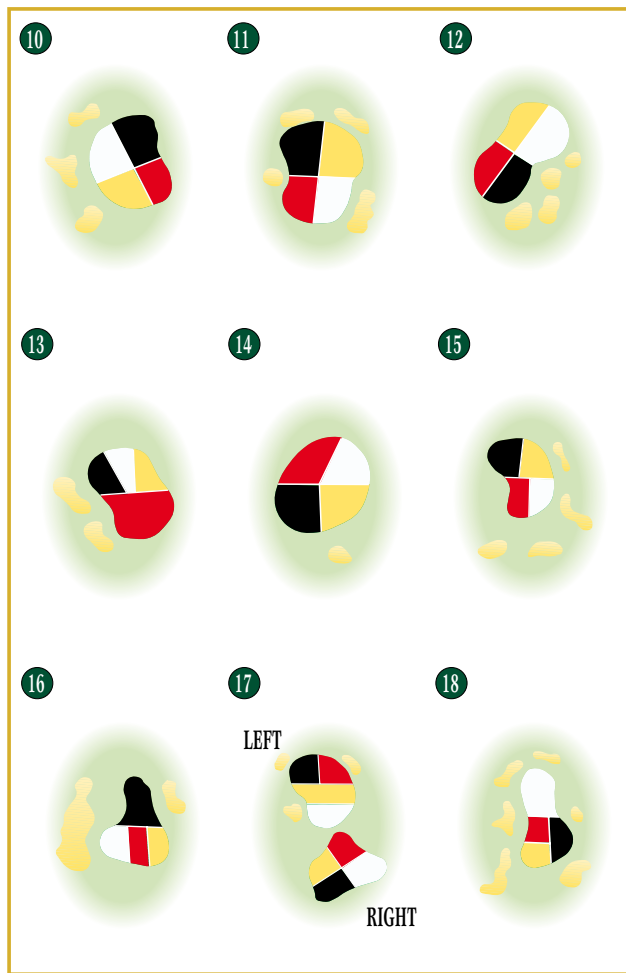


Pin Placement Zones Holes 1 to 9

LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT-OF-BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
(a) Beyond any white stakes, fence, hedge or wall bordering the course.
(b) Practice ground to the left of the 10th hole, the stake trees defining.
(c) In and beyond the river to the left of the 8th hole.
(d) Beyond the buggy path immediately behind the 2nd green.
(e) On the 6th fairway over or to the right when playing the 5th hole.
- 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
(a) The fenced enclosure between the tee and green on the 17th hole.
(b) All rivers, lakes and ditches crossing fairways shall be treated as water hazards
(c) All rivers, lakes and ditches running parallel to the hole shall be treated as lateral water hazards
(d) When obtaining relief from the brook on the 17th hole the player must use the drop zone nearest to their point of entry
(e) When taking relief from the lateral water hazard on the 18th hole please note that a ball coming to rest on the Cotswold stone wall, forming the boundary to the lake, is also part of that lateral water hazard.
- 3. BUNKERS**
(a) Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1).
- 4. GROUND UNDER REPAIR**
(a) Includes all vehicle marks, tractor damage and similar, newly turred and seeded areas, unfinished course work, hoof marks and all areas marked G.U.R. (Rule 25).
- 5. STAKED TEES AND SHRUBS**
(a) If these interfere with a players stance or arc of swing the ball **MUST** be lifted and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief without penalty, not nearer the hole avoiding damage (Rule 24-2b).
- 6. FIXED SPINKLER HEADS**
(a) These are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, players may obtain relief without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is not nearer the hole, avoids such intervention and is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- 7. BIGGEST PUTTS**
(a) All buggy paths are immovable obstructions, relief can be taken under Rule 24-2b.
- 8. DEER FENCING**
(a) All deer fencing is an integral part of the course and the ball played as it lies.

(a) Through the green a ball embedded in its own pitchmark in ground other than hazards, may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty within one club length of the ball.
- 11. SPLIT OF PLAY**
(a) Please keep within the hole timings on the scorecard. Allow any faster match to play through regardless of the number of players.
- 12. BUBBLES**
(a) Our parland course is fragile therefore please keep all buggies on the paths provided at all times.
